WINTER UNIFORM

- Weatherproof outdoor coat, plain black or navy.
No logos*
- School scarf (optional)
- School navy blazer
- School tartan tie
- White long-sleeved shirt*
- School tartan skirt
- School tartan trousers
- School navy cardigan or jumper
- Navy tights or (knee high) navy long socks*

SUMMER UNIFORM as for winter except for:

- Short-sleeved white shirt*
- Knee high navy long socks*
- No open-toe sandals



SPORTS KIT

- School polo shirt
- School skort
- School girls' shorts
- White sport ankle socks*
- School sports tracksuit
- School sports socks

ACCESSORIES

- Black leather shoes* (please see rules)

Uniform Rules (taken from Senior School Rules)

- Pupils must be smartly dressed in the specified uniform. Blouses and shirts must be tucked in. Skirts should be no shorter than just above the knee. All ties must be tied appropriately and adjusted correctly at the neck, with the collar correctly fastened. Only plain white T-shirts (no logos) may be worn under a shirt. Blazers must be worn when moving around the school during and in between lesson time. Girls' and boys' shoes must be black, formal and of a traditional style and should not resemble trainers. Ankle boots, heels and open toe shoes are not permitted.
- Outdoor coats must be plain navy or black and cover the school blazer; hoodies, gilets and body warmers are not acceptable.

- Boys' socks must be dark in colour. Girls may wear navy ankle socks, navy long socks or navy tights. Over the knee socks are not permissible.
- Hair gels, waxes and sprays should only be used in moderation. Hair is to be neat, with no extremes of style and colour. Pupils must not style their hair in a way which impedes their vision. Long hair should be tied back. Hair bands should be white, black, dark blue or brown and without excessive embellishments or patterns. Hair must not have lines or patterns shaved into the scalp.
- Make up is not permissible for Upper 3 (Year 7) or Lower 4 (Year 8). For pupils in Upper 4 (Year 9) to Upper 5 (Year 11), discreet foundation, mascara and eye liner is all that is allowed. False nails (acrylic/gel/stick on) are not allowed during term time due to health and safety reasons. Only clear nail varnish may be worn. False lashes are not permitted. Fake tan is not permitted. The only jewellery allowed is a simple watch and a single pair of stud earrings, worn one in each earlobe. Hoop earrings are not allowed for health and safety reasons. All jewellery must be removed for PE and Games lessons.
- Smart watches must not be connected to blue tooth and must not enable pupils to access the internet, or social media and must not be used to communicate with others.
- School P.E./Games kit is compulsory and should be worn to every P.E./Games lesson.
- Aerosols and perfume sprays are not permitted in school. Pupils may use a roll-on deodorant after PE/Games lessons if they wish to do so.

General Notes

Please ensure all items of uniform are clearly marked with the pupil's name.

After Michaelmas half-term winter uniform is compulsory until Trinity Term. After Trinity half-term summer uniform is compulsory until Michaelmas Term.
