For the 2020/21 academic year I will be coordinating the Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme from St John's School.

The DofE Award Scheme is a life-changing experience and an opportunity to discover new interests and talents. Participants aged 14-24 years old can do a DofE programme at one of three progressive levels which, when successfully completed, leads to a Bronze, Silver or Gold Duke of Edinburgh's Award. Participants are involved in helping the community/environment, becoming fitter, developing new skills, planning, training for and completing an expedition.

The award scheme will involve taking part in two expeditions including a training expedition and an assessment expedition; both take place off school site in the Essex countryside. The expeditions will run in May, June or July next year (2021). Training for the expeditions involves learning to map read, emergency first aid training and orienteering skills. The expeditions provide a wonderful opportunity for developing team building and problem-solving skills.

The expeditions are organised through a company called Mud and Maps. Vicky Munday will be coordinating this aspect of the award scheme. Please note that there is a charge of approximately £185 for the two expeditions (training and assessment). This cost includes all the training, loan of the kit and all camping equipment, which is payable <u>directly</u> to Mud and Maps. Booking for this aspect of the award scheme is through the Mud and Maps website directly and is available from February onwards.

Please note there is a charge of £65 for the DofE welcome pack. Please make payment via BACs transfer (regular account) or cheques payable to St John's School. Please clearly reference 'DofE' and your child's name when making payment.
