Uniform may be purchased from the School Uniform Shop. All items marked * cannot be obtained from the School. Please adhere to the points from our School Rules;

- Pupils must be smartly dressed in the specified uniform. Blouses and shirts must be tucked in. All ties must be tied appropriately and adjusted correctly at the neck, with the collar correctly fastened. Only plain white T-shirts (no logos) may be worn under a shirt. Blazers must be worn when moving around the school during lesson time. Girls' and boys' shoes must be formal and substantial and of a traditional style and should not resemble trainers. Ankle boots are not permitted.
- Outdoor coats must be plain navy, black or dark grey and cover the school blazer; gilets and body warmers are not acceptable. Scarves and hats must be plain in colour and ideally navy, black or dark grey.
- Boys' socks must be dark in colour. Girls may wear navy knee high socks or navy tights. Over the knee socks are not permissible.





- Hair gels, waxes and sprays should only be used in moderation. Hair is to be neat, with no extremes of style and colour. Pupils must not style their hair in a way which impedes their vision. Long hair should be tied back for practical subjects. Hair bands should be neutral in colour, e.g. white, black, dark blue or brown and without excessive embellishments.
- Make-up should be discreet for Upper 4 (Year 9) to Upper 5 (Year 11) and is not permissible for Upper 3 (Year 7) or Lower 4 (Year 8). Discreet foundation, mascara and eye liner is all that is allowed. Discreet is defined by the school as not drawing attention to the wearer. False nails (acrylic/gel/stick on) are not allowed during term time due to health and safety reasons. Only clear nail varnish may be worn. Hoop earrings are not allowed for health and safety reasons. Girls may wear a single pair of stud earrings, one stud in each ear.
- Full P.E/Games kit is compulsory and should be worn to every P.E./Games lesson.

Please ensure all items of uniform are clearly marked with the pupil's name. Blazers must be worn to and from School. Uniform may not be altered in order to change the style of clothing. After Michaelmas half-term winter uniform is compulsory until Trinity Term. After Trinity half-term summer uniform is compulsory until Michaelmas Term.
